

The Council of the City of Parksville hereby gives notice, in accordance with Section 59 of the *Community Charter Act of BC*, of an opportunity for citizens and businesses to make representation to Council with respect to the proposed "Business Licence Amendment Bylaw, 2018, No. 1483.2".

The purpose of the amendment is to temporarily prohibit non-medicinal cannabis related activities in the City of Parksville. This interim measure will allow Council to design a regulatory framework for the City that takes into consideration the results of the recent public engagement survey and recommendations from staff on a tailored approach to cannabis legalization.

Representations may be in writing, via email or as a delegation before Council at the open Council meeting to be held on Monday, May 7, 2018, at 6 pm in the Forum at Parksville Civic and Technology Center, 100 Jensen Avenue East, Parksville, BC.

Persons wishing to make representation in writing or to appear as a delegation before Council must have their submission received at the City of Parksville's Administration Department, 100 Jensen Avenue East by noon on Wednesday, April 25, 2018.
