City of Parksville Licence Renewals for 2022

Due January 31, 2022, City of Parksville dog and business licence renewals will be mailed to residents and businesses in early December and <u>may be paid at that time</u>.

2022 Business Licences - renewals are due January 31, 2022, and may be paid as follows:

- Credit card (Visa or Mastercard) payments from the City's website [Online Services>Online Payments]
- By mail (P O Box 1390, Parksville V9P 2H3)
- Dropbox at City Hall (100 Jensen Avenue East)
- In-person at City Hall (Monday to Friday, 8 am to 4 pm)

Business licence fees which remain unpaid after January 31, 2022, will be subject to fines.

<u>2022 Dog Licences</u> - fees are due by January 31. If you do not receive a notice in December and currently own a dog, licences may be purchased in-person from City Hall (open Monday to Friday, 8 am to 4 pm) and the BCSPCA (open Tuesday to Saturday, noon to 4 pm).

The main benefit of licensing is the quick return of dogs should they become lost. As well, fees collected help to offset the cost to maintain our off-leash dog park, provide bags and dispensers throughout the City and provide bylaw enforcement to handle public safety concerns of stray, off-leash and dangerous dogs.

All dogs over the age of six months must wear a municipal dog tag, which must be renewed yearly. Rates for tags are as follows:

By January 31 Spayed/neutered \$20, not spayed/neutered \$30 After January 31 Spayed/neutered \$25, not spayed/neutered \$35
