

Parksville Wetlands – Next Phase of Upgrade

City upgrades to the trails in the Parksville Wetlands will continue in the new year. Beginning January 4, crews will complete a loop on the north side of the railway line through the Parksville Wetlands, connecting the Hirst/Renz corner of the property to the end of Despard Avenue. This work will complete a 2.3-kilometer loop trail within this side of the wetlands. Work is expected to take up to six weeks.

Development of a trail system within the Parksville Wetlands is a priority for the City. As climate change contributes to drier summers, it is critical to provide access for maintenance, emergency vehicles and fire protection for the Parksville Wetlands and surrounding areas. It is also important to provide formal access for users to enjoy our parks.

For those using the park, please respect signage which advises of any trail closures and please keep dogs on leash to avoid conflict with equipment.
