Regional District of Nanaimo Services and Closures for September 19

The Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) is recognizing the September 19 national holiday announced by the federal government to honour and mourn the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. Some RDN services will be impacted on Monday, September 19 as follows.

RDN Administrative Services

- The administration office will be closed; however, the public can continue to access RDN services through alternate means including:
