


Pavement Condition Assessment of Parksville Streets

The City has entered into a professional services agreement with Tetra Tech Canada Inc for a pavement condition assessment of every road and lane in Parksville. You might just see the *ride van* working its way along Parksville streets this month. The ride van will travel along City roadways at the posted speed limit, posing no interruption to traffic during the survey.

The ride van incorporates laser crack

measurement, LiDAR, GPS, 360-degree imaging, and a digital right-of-way imaging system which will record the condition of every Parksville road and lane this spring. The ride van will also pickup georeferenced pavement markings and signage which will help to improve our annual maintenance and replacement programs as well as information for a future traffic network analysis. The information gathered through this analysis will support the City's road maintenance and renewal programs, asset management system, and longrange capital renewal plans.

Appropriately timed pavement surface treatments such as overlays can help extend the life of the entire pavement structure to better align with underlying utilities, improve the overall condition, safety, and road experience while optimizing costs to the City.
