Utility bills have arrived in mailboxes. The utility bill is sent twice a year to bill for water, sewer, and solid waste (garbage, green bin, and recycling services).

There are many ways to pay by the due date of April 28 and don't forget, there's a discount if paid by April 28. You are welcome to pay at City Hall, 100 Jensen Avenue East; however, here are ways for you to skip the line:

- Mail cheque to P O Box 1390, Parksville V9P 2H3
- Pay at your financial institution
- Use the dropbox located at Jensen Avenue entrance to Parksville Civic and Technology Centre
- Use online or telephone banking
- Register for MyCity

And, you may wish to consider PAWS - <u>Pre-Authorized Withdrawal Service</u>, a preauthorized withdrawal plan which allows homeowners to contribute a fixed monthly payment towards their taxes and/or utilities. Info on our website.
