


## Springwood Pumpstation High Pressure Upgrade

Due to repairs needed on the high-pressure pumps at the Springwood pumpstation, residents in the vicinity of the Hamilton Avenue, Trill Drive, Maple Glen area, Chestnut Street, Lodgepole Drive area, and all areas west of Pym Street from Hirst to Temple should expect a noticeable drop in water pressure on Wednesday, February 7, from 8 am to 4 pm.

The expected reduction in water pressure will impact the daily use of water. On February 7, residents are encouraged to voluntarily restrict where possible, household water consumption by limiting outside washing of vehicles and driveways as well as indoor consumption such as laundry. The area in the City which will be affected by this maintenance is highlighted in yellow.
