Street Tree Lights on Alberni Highway

During the week of March 3, a City contractor will remove the lights on the street trees along Alberni Highway and replace with new strings of lights on a total of twenty trees. These lights will remain in place year-round. The work which will begin on Monday, March 3, is expected to take most of the week with the contractor working from 7.30 am to 3.30 pm daily.

Throughout the week of March 3, parking on Alberni Highway will be interrupted. As the lights are installed and it is safe to do so, parking spaces will be made available. The contractor will begin the work near the Royal Bank on the east side of Alberni Highway, moving towards the Chevron Station at Highway 19A. The second phase of the work will start at the CIBC at Highway 19A working up Alberni Highway to the Rod and Gun liquor store.
