

Removal of Beach Access Ramp in Parksville Community Park

The obsolete concrete beach access ramp in the Parksville Community Park will be removed on Monday, March 31, expected to take most of the day. The first parking area past the waterfront gazebo will be closed to accommodate equipment necessary for the removal.

Earlier this year, the ramp collapsed and is being removed for safety and environmental concerns. A qualified environmental professional will be on site to monitor the work as required by provincial and federal government permits.

The cost of this rehabilitation work is eligible for provincial Local Government Climate Action Partnership funding.
