

Paving Work in Parksville Community Park

During the week of April 28, pavement patching work will occur in the Parksville Community Park, expected to take three days and is weather dependent.

Road access in the park will be maintained; however, there will be various road closures within the park during this time which may cause disruptions such as single lane alternating or cause a detour through the park.

The tentative schedule is as follows:

- Day 1- mill, remove, place gravel, and fine grade on Ravenhill Road.
- Day 2- mill and pave patches on Salish Sea Drive and pave Ravenhill Road. Paving of patches near the gate on Salish Sea Drive will be completed early in the day.
- Day 3- mill and pave patches on Sandcastle Drive and pave speed bumps on Ravenhill Road.

Please follow the instructions of traffic control personnel.
