A graduation and badge pinning ceremony was held earlier this month with six volunteer firefighter recruits completing initial recruit training and becoming full members of the Parksville Volunteer Fire Department. Recruit graduates now serving the community are Eric Taylor, Koen Barbeau, Kobe Allerton, Matthew Staples, Jaden Dodds, and Andrew Smee.

Recruit class 2024 began their training in May 2024. Firefighter recruits complete about 300 hours of intensive coursework, training and hands-on experience, and graduate having achieved most of the training required for their National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 1001 Level 1 and 2 certificates.

As the Parksville Fire Protection Area continues to grow, the need for skilled emergency responders is critical to providing emergency services to our residents.
