## **COUNCIL RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING REPORTS**

- Received a report regarding a permanent closure and disposal of a portion of Despard Avenue West adjacent to 423 Alberni Highway. Staff were directed to give notice and prepare the bylaw and commence the statutory process.
- Received a report regarding a zoning amendment application at 423 Alberni Highway. The property owners are required to host a public engagement opportunity and post notice signage and staff was directed to finalize the preparation of the zoning bylaw.
- Received a report regarding a liquor primary licence application for a new patio at the Parksville Curling Club
  (193 Island Highway East). The applicant is required to place notice on the property advertising opportunity for
  public input.

• Endorsed a motion for submission of a resolution to the annual UBCM convention regarding incorporating climate resiliency, watershed capacity, and infrastructure readiness into housing target formulas.
