Indigenous Survivors Day Proclaimed in the City

At the June 16 Council meeting, Mayor Doug O'Brien proclaimed June 30, 2025, as Indigenous Survivors Day in the City of Parksville. The proclamation is included with this release. The intention of Indigenous Survivors Day is to recognize and honour the enduring resilience of Indigenous communities.

Each year, the City recognizes National Indigenous Peoples Day on June 21 and the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on September 30 and are honoured to once again include acknowledgement of Indigenous Survivors Day in 2025.

PROCLAMATION

INDIGENOUS SURVIVORS DAY June 30, 2025

WHEREAS Parksville City Council recognizes the historical injustices endured by Indigenous

peoples due to colonization, forced assimilation, and systemic discrimination; and

WHEREAS Indigenous Survivors Day on June 30 provides an opportunity to acknowledge the

resilience, strength, and cultural heritage of Indigenous communities who have

persevered through historical traumas; and

WHEREAS designating June 30 as Indigenous Survivors Day creates a platform for healing,

education and dialogue, raising awareness about the unique struggles faced by

Indigenous peoples; and

WHEREAS this observance serves as a solemn reminder of the ongoing challenges faced by

Indigenous communities and highlights the importance of supporting their cultural

heritage and promoting understanding; and

WHEREAS Indigenous Survivors Day fosters inclusivity, unity, and a sense of solidarity among

community members, promoting reconciliation and justice; and

WHEREAS by implementing Indigenous Survivors Day on June 30, Parksville City Council

demonstrates its commitment to honouring Indigenous survivors, promoting

healing and building a more equitable and inclusive city.
