WORLD WATER DAY ART CONTEST
CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

City of Parksville and the Oceanside Community Arts Council

1. Each artist may enter only once.
2. All work must be recent and original 2 dimensional art including recent photographs. No kits, moulds, commercial prints, or giclée prints are acceptable.
3. No electronic submissions or entry forms will be accepted.
4. The work must not be framed.
5. Photographs are limited to maximum size of 8"X10" (20.3 cm X 25.4 cm); other media 9"X12" (22.9cm X 30.4 cm) maximum.
6. The art work must reflect, in some manner, *Water in Parksville*. The artist must state where the inspiration for the art work came from on the entry form.
7. **ENTRY DEADLINE: April 16, 2010 (no later than 4 pm)**. Entries must be accompanied by a signed and dated World Water Day Art Contest entry form. Entries must be delivered to Parksville City Hall between 8 am and 4 pm, Monday to Friday prior to, or on the contest closing date. No electronic or faxed entries accepted.
8. The contest is limited to residents of Parksville, business owners with a business address in Parksville and students attending a Parksville school.
9. Complete information including the title, address, and contact information must accompany each entry form and be affixed to the back of the art work. If a student or artist is under the age of 19, the name of the school they are currently attending and their age must also be included. In the case of a business owner, the name of their business and address is to be on the entry form.
10. Although reasonable security is provided, submission of work is at the artists' risk. The City of Parksville will not be held liable for any loss or damage.
11. The work will be juried by local personalities and certificates awarded to the winners of each group and one overall winner.
12. The judges and their immediate family members are prohibited from entering the contest.
13. Winners of each category (age group) and one overall winner and family members will be contacted and invited to attend the Council meeting on May 3, 2010, to receive an award.
14. Following awards, entries may be picked up by the artist at City Hall during office hours after May 3 and no later than Friday May 28, 2010 at 4 pm. Art not picked up by that date becomes the property of the City.

The submitted photo or artwork must be the original work of the contestant. The contestant retains complete copyright but agrees to have his/her photograph or artwork published or displayed on www.parksville.ca or www.parksvilleaquastar.ca and for the purposes of promotion of the AquaStar Water Awareness program. The image must not have already been professionally commissioned. The contestant authorizes the City of Parksville to use the photograph or artwork, royalty free with credit to the photographer/artist when and wherever possible.
