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City of Parksville Releases 2009 Annual Report

Parksville, BC – The Council for the City of Parksville will formally receive the City of Parksville's 2009 Annual Report at a special Council meeting on Monday, September 13 at 6 pm, at which time the public is encouraged to provide their input and comments. The 2009 Annual Report highlights the goals and accomplishments of the City and includes reports from the mayor and chief administrative officer as well as financial statements and the auditor's report.

In accordance with the Community Charter, municipalities are required to prepare an annual report that provides a progress report on the performance of the City relative to established objectives and measures. The annual report includes a report on the municipality's services and operations for 2009 as well as a statement of municipal objectives and the measures that will be used to determine progress for 2010 and 2011. Under the provisions of the *Charter* the annual report must be available for public inspection for 14 days before the report is considered by Council.

"This report outlines the City's many accomplishments during 2009," said Mayor Ed Mayne. "The Annual Report identifies the highlights and achievements of 2009, sets out objectives and strategies for 2010 and 2011 and also provides a clear financial picture of the City of Parksville. We encourage residents to provide their comments to Council at the public meeting on September 13," said Mayor Mayne.
