

Spring 2011 Grants-In-Aid Approved by Parksville Council

Parksville, BC – The City of Parksville, under the provisions of the City's Grant-In-Aid application policy, provides direct financial assistance to community groups and organizations for events and projects that benefit the citizens and visitors of the municipality contingent upon provisions being included in the annual operating budget.

At the April 4 Council meeting, the following Grant-In-Aid applications, totalling \$2,500 for the spring intake, were approved by City Council:

The 2011 budget for Grant-In-Aid applications is \$5,000. As provided under the policy, awarding of the grants is split into a spring and fall intake with the next intake at the end of August 2011.
