

Englishman River Water Service Public Open House – Thursday, May 8

In partnership with the Englishman River Water Service, the City of Parksville and the Regional District of Nanaimo, CH2M Hill Canada Limited as project consultants will host a public open house on Thursday, May 8 to update residents on the preliminary design process for the ERWS project. The Regional District of Nanaimo will host a second meeting in Nanoose Bay in the coming weeks.

The Englishman River Water Service is working to improve the water system for the City of Parksville and the Nanoose Peninsula. This open house is an opportunity for residents of Parksville and the RDN (Nanoose) to provide comments and feedback prior to the commencement of the detailed design of the intake, treatment plant and distribution facility.

The drop-in format will enable residents to review design concepts at their leisure and to ask questions of the design team. Feedback forms will be available and participants will be encouraged to provide comments. For those with limited time, informal presentations scheduled for 3 pm and 6 pm will offer an overview of the project components.
