

Update to Temple Street Upgrade Plans

Parksville, BC — As part of ongoing capital upgrades and infrastructure renewal, the City's engineering department has received design drawings (95% complete) for the Temple Street upgrade capital works project. In consultation with civil engineering consultant, Koers and Associates Engineering Ltd, the City has decided to construct the project over two years.

The first phase of the project will be between Phillips Avenue to Chinook Avenue approximately. The total length of the Temple Street upgrade is about 2,000 meters long and includes the addition of missing infrastructure, the upgrading of older infrastructure and provision of a continuous pedestrian facility.

The City of Parksville and Koers and Associates Engineering have begun work to tender the project for summer construction however, at this time, no firm dates are available.

An initial public information session was held in March 2013 with a second information session in October 2013 at which public input was solicited and concerns gathered. At this time, the drawings are being reviewed one last time by the City prior to tendering and are available for information on the City's website for viewing.
