

Temple Street Upgrades – Concrete Curb, Sidewalk, and Road Construction

The contractor for the Temple Street upgrades will begin road reconstruction shortly. This work includes but is not limited to:

- Removal of the asphalt roadway surface
- Excavation and placement of new roadway materials
- Concrete curb and sidewalk preparation
- Pouring of concrete
- Asphalt surface paving
- Traffic line painting.

For safety reasons, the contractor has requested temporary road closures and detours around areas of reconstruction. However, local traffic access will be permitted on Temple Street for the duration of these works. Anticipated construction dates and road closure/local traffic only dates are listed here:

February 10 to April 3	Chinook Avenue to Sanderson Road
February 23 to April 30	Sanderson Road to Pym Street
March 10 to May 15	Foster Drive to Pym Street

Deviations from the above schedule may occur due to unexpected delays or inclement weather.

Extra effort will be taken by the contractor to notify residents when construction activity is occurring in their area. Due to the dynamic nature of this work, the City requires all residents to exercise extreme caution and obey all flag persons while passing through the construction zone.

As always, the City of Parksville appreciates the patience of residents while construction is taking place.
