

November 28 is Shop the Neighbourhood Day in Parksville Downtown

At the November 16 Council meeting, Acting Mayor Mary Beil proclaimed November 28 as “Shop the Neighbourhood Day in Parksville Downtown”. This proclamation was made at the request of the Parksville Downtown Business Association.

- *Shop the Neighbourhood* is a national initiative of Yellow Pages, created to give Canadians a local shopping alternative on the Saturday between Black Friday and Cyber Monday.
- The campaign raises awareness of the larger impact dollars have when spent locally.
- In 2014, over 200 business associations participated and 8,000 businesses offered 6,000 deals and promotions.
- Parksville Downtown Business Association is one of 400 business associations participating across Canada in 2015; 8,000 businesses have registered so far this year.
