Residents Invited to Help Shape Future of Community Park

The City of Parksville, in partnership with a consulting team from Vancouver Island University, is developing a long-term master plan for the Parksville Community Park, the jewel of Parksville.

In early May, Parksville residents will receive a postcard in the mail with information on how to participate in an online survey about the Parksville Community Park. Resident input will assist the City and the VIU team to identify goals and priorities for the future of the Community Park and also guide the development of the Community Park Master Plan.

The card will include a link to an online survey available at www.Parksville.ca where residents will be asked a series of questions about the Parksville Community Park. We hope to learn what it is about the Community Park you enjoy, what might be missing from the park and also what changes you would like to see in the future!

They survey will take five to ten minutes to complete and will be open until May 26. Survey responses are anonymous and because we recognize household members may have differing opinions, we are able to accept two surveys per householder (per access code) and please, just one response per person. If you do not receive a postcard in the mail or if you prefer to complete a paper copy of the survey, please contact the City of Parksville at 100 Jensen Avenue East.

Resident input is greatly appreciated and will be used to shape the future of the Community Park. The survey results will presented to the community later this summer, prior to bringing a draft to Council.
