

More time to Complete Community Park Residents Survey

The deadline for residents to complete the Community Park survey has been extended by three weeks to Friday, June 16. In partnership with a consulting team from Vancouver Island University, the City is developing a long-term master plan for the Parksville Community Park.

Earlier this month, residents received a postcard in the mail with information on how to participate in an online survey about the park. The survey is available at www.Parksville.ca and requires an access code. If residents have not received a postcard in the mail or prefer to complete a paper copy of the survey, contact the City of Parksville, 100 Jensen Avenue East; 250 248-6144.

The survey will take about ten minutes to complete and is now open until June 16. Survey responses are anonymous and because we recognize household members may have differing opinions, we are able to accept two surveys per householder (per access code) and please, just one response per person.

Resident input will assist the City and the VIU team to identify goals and priorities for the future of the Community Park and also guide the development of the Community Park Master Plan. We hope to learn what it is about the Community Park residents enjoy, what might be missing from the park and also what changes should be considered in the future!
