

Renate Sutherland to Receive 2017 Community Spirit Award

Since 2008, the organization's programs have grown immeasurably, reaching many impressive milestones.

As SOS executive director, Renate has been dedicated to the Oceanside Task Force on Homelessness both as task force co-chair and as regional coordinator for the homeless shelter. During this same time, Renate was co-chair of the Oceanside Health and Wellness Network and worked on the End of Life Care Working Group resulting in the opening of hospice beds at Trillium Lodge.

Renate's passion for helping people is not limited merely to her career and becomes even more evident in her remarkable list of personal volunteer endeavours. Although retired, Renate continues her work with the Oceanside Task Force on Homelessness, devoted to providing housing for those most vulnerable.
