

## Construction Notice – Highway 19A and Shelly Road Intersection Upgrade

The intersection at Highway 19A and Shelly Road is identified for signalization in the City's Master Transportation Plan. The contractor, Copcan Civil, will begin construction in this intersection on Monday, October 29 with work expected to complete in late December, weather permitting.

The intersection upgrade will include:

- Installation of traffic signals on Highway 19A and Shelly Road
- Streetlight upgrading at the intersection
- Crosswalk letdown modifications at all four corners of the intersection
- Concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk removal and replacement
- Line painting eradication and reinstatement on Highway 19A and Shelly Road.

### General traffic interruptions

When necessary during construction, traffic will be controlled in all directions for both vehicles and pedestrians. Please expect interruptions to traffic flow including, lane closures, turning restrictions and intermittent alternating single-lane usage. For the public's safety, the instructions provided by traffic control personnel must be followed. Access to sidewalks and pedestrian crossings within the intersection will be dependent on construction activity and should be used with caution and at the direction of traffic control personnel when present. The contractor will complete this work as efficiently and safely as possible. The City thanks residents and businesses for their patience during construction.
