New Process for BC Home Owner Grant

The home owner grant is available to eligible homeowners who pay property taxes. All home owner grant applications must now be submitted directly to the BC provincial government through a secure online application. Municipalities are no longer able to accept home owner grant applications.

This new system helps to ensure homeowners receive their full grant entitlement, including the additional grant for seniors or persons with a disability. It also helps process applications faster and reduce fraudulent applications.

The province is now accepting current year and retroactive grants online. Homeowners can apply for their current year or their retroactive home owner grants online at gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant. Note that while a homeowner can apply for their current year grant, the application will not be processed until taxes are levied in May; they will remain in a hold status.
