

Road Resurfacing on Craig Street

This notice is to advise residents, business owners and those using Craig Street of the City's planned road resurfacing along Craig Street between Hirst Avenue and Middleton Avenue intersection. We expect the paving to be completed early in the day, either Monday, November 23 or Tuesday, November 24 and is weather dependent.

Access to Craig Street from the Island Highway East will be closed off for a few hours in the morning in order to complete the work. When the asphalt paving is underway, it will be necessary to relocate vehicles off Craig Street; vehicle access will be restored at the end of the working day or once paving is completed.

This road resurfacing concludes the pedestrian improvements completed in October which included the removal of all existing exposed aggregate concrete wheelchair and driveway ramps, re-installation of City of Parksville standard wheelchair and driveway ramps, the installation of a new crosswalk and wheelchair ramp at the corner of Middleton Avenue and Craig Street (adjacent to the Community Credit Union driveway) to City standards.

The pedestrian upgrades have significantly improved the delineation between the level sidewalk and wheelchair and driveway ramps for the vision impaired as well as improve access safety for the mobility challenged. These upgrades are in line with the pedestrian safety recommendations provided by the Municipal Insurance Association of British Columbia specifically for the City of Parksville.
