

## ERWS Water Project Assent Voting Results

**Parksville, BC:** The preliminary results for the assent voting opportunity held November 21, 2015, are shown here:

<b>YES</b>	<b>1,437</b>
<b>NO</b>	<b>357</b>
<b>TOTAL VOTES</b>	<b>1,794</b>

This reflects 80% in favour of the borrowing bylaw and 20% opposed.

Parksville residents were asked to approve a bylaw to authorize the borrowing of up to \$5.6 million to construct a new water intake, water treatment plant and transmission lines. The assent voting question read as follows:

*Do you agree to the adoption of City of Parksville Loan Authorization Bylaw, 2015, No. 1519 which will authorize the City of Parksville to borrow \$5.6 million to construct a water intake and treatment facility in accordance with Island Health requirements.*

The determination of preliminary results was made by the Chief Election Officer at 8.20 pm on Saturday, November 21. Official results will be announced at 3.30 pm on Monday, November 23, in the Forum, Parksville Civic and Technology Centre.
