Highlights from Council Meeting on August 9, 2017

Mayor Lefebvre recognized the people of the Coast Salish Nations and their territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

Delegations

- A presentation by Sharon Welch, chair and Brenda Kent, coordinator of the Oceanside Health and Wellness Network (OHWN), a community-based network of individuals and organizations working collectively to address complex health issues, updated Council on its organizational structure, priorities and upcoming events.

Reports

- Council approved a development permit for an industrial facility at 1023 Herring Gull Way with a landscaping security of \$34,850.
- Council received an update on the status of the totem pole project and approved a resolution to authorize insurance coverage during the repair, restoration and creation of a replacement Canada 150 totem pole and approved the necessary agreements to carry out the project.

Bylaws

- Zoning and Development Amendment Bylaw, 2016, No. 2000.104 (451, 461 and 465 Hirst Avenue) was read a third time.

New Business

- Council instructed staff to look at the feasibility of extending a no parking zone along the south side of Stanford Avenue from Blower Road eastward to Shelly Road and prepare a report to Council.
