Highlights from Council Meeting on August 8, 2018

Mayor Lefebvre recognized the people of the Coast Salish Nations and their territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

New Business

- Council established an Art in Public Spaces select committee with Councillors Beil, Burden and Patterson appointed as Council representatives.
- Council directed staff to amend the traffic bylaw to include a parking setback around community mailboxes.
- Council directed staff to review the City's current parcel coverage restrictions to better accommodate buildings, gazeboes, decks, patio covers, awnings and similar accessory structures.

Presentations

- The Parksville Downtown Business Association provided an update on the pedestrian wayfinding project and Council approved disbursement of allocated funds for the next phase.

Delegations

- Timberlake Jones Engineering addressed Council regarding the zoning amendment application at 331 and 343 Moilliet Street.
- The property owner of 1 Trill Drive addressed Council regarding a development variance permit application.
- The property owner of 354 Island Highway West addressed Council regarding the proposed nuisance declaration.

Correspondence

- Council received correspondence from the Association of Vancouver Island Coastal Communities regarding an invitation to host the annual convention in 2020 or 2021.
- Council received correspondence from the Parksville Qualicum Beach Tourism Association and expressed its support for the renewal of the Municipal Regional District Tax.

Reports

- Staff received authorization to proceed with an encroachment agreement request and development variance permit application for 1 Trill Drive and were directed to proceed with required notice once sufficient information is provided by the applicant.
- Council received a report on the zoning amendment for 331 and 343 Moilliet Street South and advanced the bylaw to the statutory process.
- Council received a report on the zoning amendment for 161 and 173 Moilliet Street North and advanced the bylaw to the statutory process.
- Council accepted a proposed payment in the amount of \$229,100 in lieu of the required 5% parkland for the subdivision of 151 Despard Avenue West and 292 Stanford Avenue West.
- Council issued a development permit to facilitate the subdivision of 151 Despard Avenue West and 292 Stanford Avenue West.

- Staff provided a verbal report in response to a Council resolution requesting staff investigate the possibility of installing a traffic light on the Island Highway.
- The property at 354 Island Highway West was declared a nuisance property.
- Council received a report regarding the proposed false alarm bylaw, advanced the bylaws to the statutory process and directed staff to undertake public education activities.

Bylaws

- Bylaw No. 2000.119, a zoning amendment for 331 and 343 Moilliet Street South, and Bylaw No. 2000.120, a text amendment to the SLR-1 zone, received first reading.
- Bylaw No. 2000.117, a zoning amendment for 161 and 173 Moilliet Street, received second reading and was advanced to a public hearing to be held September 17.
- Bylaw No. 2000.118, a zoning amendment for 440 Island Highway West, received third reading.
- Bylaw No. 1542, a false alarm bylaw, and Bylaw No. 1486.8, an amendment to the offence notice bylaw, received three readings.
