Highlights from the Council Meeting on November 3, 2025

Mayor O'Brien recognized the Coast Salish peoples and their traditional territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

REPORTS

- Approved the 2026 Council appointments.
- Authorized staff to apply for, receive and manage grant funding from the UBCM Community Emergency Program Fund to enhance the capacity of Oceanside Emergency Support Services.
- Received a report regarding infrastructure report cards and a report regarding funding alternatives for long-term infrastructure renewal. Council deferred consideration of funding alternatives to the 2026 - 2030 financial plan deliberations.
- Directed staff to coordinate, schedule and manage the delivery of mobile food services in the Parksville Community Park on an ongoing basis.
- Reconsidered the Council code of conduct, as required by legislation, and confirmed the existing policy meets the prescribed principles for codes of conduct and complies with the prescribed legislative requirements.

NOTICE OF MOTION

- Councillor Grenz provided notice of his intention to introduce a motion regarding appointment of a new Council liaison to the Parksville Community Centre Society.

NEW BUSINESS

- Councillor Gaur provided an update on federal bail reforms.
- Councillor Grenz advised Council of potential local events coinciding with the 2026 FIFA World Cup and provided notice he may introduce a motion during the 2026 - 2030 financial plan deliberations regarding funding for these local events.

BYLAWS

- The following bylaw was adopted:
 - "Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw, 2025, No .1515.7" (*electric vehicle charging fees; alternative notice delivery for development applications*)
