## **Highlights from the Council Meeting of Monday, May 15, 2017**

### **Delegations**

- Jon Preston, a teacher at Ballenas Secondary School, and two BSS students gave Council a presentation to thank Council for their support of their trip to Vimy Ridge.
- Sharon Todd and Dr. Peter Haslett of the Oceanside Division of Family Practice updated Council on physician recruitment in Parksville and the surrounding area.
- Garwin Wuerch of Radcliffe Development Corporation presented the proposed development permit and development variance permit applications for 272 Island Highway West.

### **Reports**

- Staff were directed to provide notice of Council's intent to consider issuance of a development variance permit to the owners of 272 Island Highway West.
- Council passed a motion to advise the BC Liquor Control and Licensing Branch that the City has no objection to the addition of a Lounge Endorsement for Arrowsmith Brewing Company Ltd. existing liquor licence at 109 - 425 Stanford Avenue East.
- Council issued a development permit to facilitate a water treatment plant, workshop, storage shed, parking area and landscaping at 1116 Herring Gull Way.
- Council approved a lease agreement with the Parksville Community Garden Society.
- Council reported on the appointment of members to the Advisory Design Panel.

### **New Business**

- Council approved the Ballenas Secondary School request to paint a rainbow crosswalk in front of the school in support of the LGBTQ community.
