### Highlights from Council Meeting on February 4, 2019

*Mayor Mayne recognized the people of the Coast Salish Nations and their territory upon which we gather with gratitude.*

#### Presentations

- The Oceanside RCMP detachment staff sergeant provided an update on incident statistics.
- The Director of Finance gave a presentation on budget items relating to the RCMP and solid waste management.

#### Business Arising from Delegations

- Council declined sponsorship of the second annual Symposium on Water Stewardship in a Changing Climate.

#### Correspondence

- Council declined the Coldest Night of the Year event organizer's request to waive the City's special event damage deposit requirement.

#### Reports

- The Emergency Program Coordinator provided a verbal update on current emergency program initiatives.
- Council approved issuance of a development permit to facilitate a four-storey rental apartment building at 155 Moilliet Street North.
- The mandate of the Advisory Design Panel was renewed. Staff was directed to seek candidates to fill vacancies and draft referral criteria for applications which should be referred to the ADP.
- Council approved issuance of an amended development permit to facilitate a non-permanent sales office building at 100 Lombardy Street.
- Staff was authorized to award the design and construction contracts for a Moss Avenue water main replacement.
- A proposed Request for Proposals for the occupation of the Community Park mobile food vending pads was deferred pending a special Committee of the Whole meeting to receive input from the Parksville Downtown Business Association and Parksville and District Chamber of Commerce.
- Staff was directed to draft an amended Community Park Commercial Recreational Use Policy No. 3.34 and an associated request for proposals that would permit a commercial use related to non-motorized water sports in the Community Park for the 2019 summer season.

#### Policy Review

- Council approved the amended Bylaw Enforcement Policy No. 3.33.

#### Bylaws

- Bylaw No. 2000.119, a map amendment to small-lot residential for 331 and 343 Moilliet Street South, and Bylaw No. 2000.120, a text amendment to small-lot residential zone, received third reading.
