Property Taxes Due Monday, July 4

If you did not receive your 2022 tax notice by June 8, phone 250 248-6144. Payments must be received and home owner grants must be claimed by the due date of July 4 to avoid the 2% penalty. All eligible homeowners will be required to apply for their home owner grant with the Province of BC at *gov.bc.ca/homeownergrant* or by phone at 1 888 355-2700. When making a payment at a bank or through online banking, please allow a minimum of two business days for bank processing time.

Things to Know...

- **Water Restriction Stage 2** are now in effect through September 30 (unless otherwise notified). Stage 2 allows for every other day lawn watering between 7-10 am or 7-10 pm for a maximum of two hours. Vegetable gardens and fruit trees are exempt from all watering restrictions. [Quicklinks/Water Conservation]
- **Permissive Tax Exemptions** under provisions of the Community Charter, Council may exempt land and/or improvements from municipal property taxes for the next calendar year, subject to certain requirements which in general, restrict exemption to non-profit organizations using the lands for specific non-profit purposes. Application deadline 4 pm, June 30. Details, form and policy may be obtained from City Hall or website [City Hall/Mayor and Council/Permissive Tax Exemptions].
- **Controlling Non-native Species** invasive plant species are a concern to the City. Many invasive plant species thrive in our mild climate and can displace our native species. Each year, Council funds a budget for the control of invasive plants in our community, primarily focusing on Japanese Knotweed and Giant Hogweed. PARKSVILLE VOTES 2022



You may vote in the Parksville municipal election as a <u>resident</u> elector if you meet <u>all</u> these requirements; it does not matter if you rent or own your own home.

- You are a Canadian citizen
- You are or will be 18 years of age or more (October 15, 2004) on or before general voting day
- You have lived in BC for at least 6 months (as of April 14, 2022) prior to registration
- Be a resident of the municipality on the day of registration
- You are not disqualified from voting by the Local Government Act or any other act

When arriving to vote, you will be required to provide two pieces of identification; one containing your name and address, the other with your name and signature. If you do not have documentation showing residency, then two pieces of identification (with at least one with a signature) are still required and you will be required to make a "solemn declaration" as to your residency.
