General Voting Day

You may vote in the Parksville local government election as a resident elector if you

meet these requirements. It does not matter whether you rent or own your home.

• Have lived in BC for at least six months (April 14, 2022) prior to registration

• Are not disgualified from voting by the Local Government Act or any other act.

The City continues to use "voting day only registration" and does not use a voters' list. Voters register on the day of voting, at either advance voting or on general voting day.

When arriving to vote, you will be required to provide two pieces of identification; one containing your name and address, the other containing your name and signature. If you do not have documentation showing residency, then two pieces of identification

(at least one with a signature) are required and you will be required to make a "solemn

Residents must bring two pieces of identification; documents which may be accepted are:

• Are, or will be, 18 years of age or more (October 15, 2004) on or before general

• Utility bill for electricity, gas, water, phone, or internet/cable services Where can I get more information?

The City's website and Let's Talk Parksville provide detailed election information such as frequently asked questions, information for non-resident property electors, candidate contact information and nomination papers. Letstalkparksville.ca/election-2022. The declaration of unofficial results will be announced October 15 and official results by Ocotber 19. The inaugural meeting of the newly elected Council will be held on November 7 at 1 pm.
