IT'S SUMMER IN THE CITY!




Parksville's Beach Festival

Five weeks of summer fun in Parksville

July and August are Beach Festival months in Parksville and as well as sand sculpting, activities include Kitefest (July 21-22), Artisans at the Beach (July 28-29), Oceanside Overdrive Car Show (August 5), Quality Foods Fireworks (August 18), Kidfest (August 19) and daily entertainment during Beach Festival.



The City is proud to be one of the community sponsors of the 2012 Quality Foods Canadian Open Sand Sculpting Competition and Exhibition which is also part of the Parksville Beach Festival. The competition starts on July 14 with events running through August 19, open daily 9 am to 9 pm. In 1982, 100 people attended the first "BC Open" competition. Get on the Parksville Free Bus

The Downtown Free Bus, provided by the Parksville Downtown Business Association, is rolling again this summer. The bus runs until September 1; 9 am to 6 pm except on Tuesdays when it operates from noon to 9 pm to support the Summer by the Sea Street Market. The bus brings riders from the resort areas and outlying neighbourhoods to explore and enjoy the shops and services in our downtown. Reminder of Level 2 Water Conservation

Water Conservation Level 2, now in effect, allows a total of four hours watering per watering day. Watering times are 6 am to 10 am and 6 pm to 10 pm on an every other day basis. Nominate an Exceptional Canadian Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal Program

The City is accepting nominations for Council's consideration for a Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal. Municipalities in Canada have been offered the opportunity to nominate a candidate and one alternate candidate. To be eligible for this honour, a person:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, but need not necessarily reside in Canada.
- Must have made a significant contribution to a particular province, territory, region or community within Canada, or an achievement abroad that brings credit to Canada.
- Must have been alive on February 6, 2012.
- Must currently be a resident or have been previously a resident of Parksville (City of Parksville criteria).

Nominations should be submitted on the application form on the City's website [City Hall/Mayor and Council] or from the administration department at City Hall. Questions should be directed to 250 954-3073.

Grant-in-Aid Applications

Subject to the provisions of Grant-in-Aid Applications Policy 3.26, the City may provide direct financial assistance to community groups and organizations for events that benefit our citizens and visitors. Non-profit organizations wishing to apply should obtain a copy of the policy to ensure their submission meets the criteria. Copies of the policy and application form may be obtained at City Hall or from the City's website [City Hall/Mayor & Council].

The Grant-in-Aid Select Committee will review the applications and make recommendations to Council. Council is not obligated to allocate any or all of the \$2,500 budgeted funds. Only complete applications will be considered. Deadline is 4 pm, August 31. Submission may be made in person or by mail to the administration department at City Hall.
