VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

- •General Voting Day is Saturday, October 22 from 8 am to 8 pm for qualiied electors of the City of Parksville at the Parksville Baptist Church, 550 Pym Street.
- Advance Voting will be at the Parksville Community and Conference Centre, 132 Jensen Avenue East from 8 am to 8 pm on Wednesday, October 12 and Wednesday, October 19.
- •Curbside voting will be available on General Voting Day and at the Advance Voting for electors unable to enter the voting place because of physical or impaired mobility.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

With two pieces of ID, you may register at the time of voting. There is no advance registration for either resident or non-resident property electors and the requirement for a non-resident property elector certificate has been removed. To register you must meet the following qualifications:


- Canadian citizen;
- •18 years of age or older (October 22, 1998, or before) on general voting day;

Resident of British Columbia for at least six months before you register to vote (April 22, 2016, last day to meet six month registration requirement);

- •Either a resident OR registered owner of real property, in the City of Parksville for at least 30 days or more before you register to vote (**September 21, 2016**, last day to meet 30 day residency requirement); and
- •Not disqualiied by the *Local Government Act* or any other act from voting in an election or otherwise disqualiied by

Resident electors must produce two pieces of identication (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity. Non-resident property electors must produce two pieces of identication (at least one with a signature) to prove identity and a copy of land title registration or tax notice which provides proof that they are entitled to register. If the property for which you are registering to vote is owned by more than one owner, the written consent of the majority of the owners must be presented at time of registration.
