# **OUTDOOR BURNING**

## **Outdoor Burning Bylaw No. 1428**

### Can I burn yard waste in my backyard?

No. Burning any type of waste is prohibited in the City.

#### Can I have a fire for a backyard cookout?

Yes, with some requirements:

- Fuel must be charcoal, wood, propane or natural gas.
- Fire must be contained in a BBQ, hibachi, fire pit or outdoor fireplace covered with a grate.
- Fireplace must be less than 0.5 metres in size (diameter, width and depth) and less than 1.8 metres in height (including chimney).
- Person 18 years or older must be present at all times.
- Fire must be completely extinguished, and residue disposed of to eliminate any fire hazard.

## **MAKING A COMPLAINT**

To make a bylaw complaint you need to provide:

- > Time, date and other details of incident.
- Location/address of incident.
- > Your name, address, phone number and email.

To report an open fire in the Parksville Fire Protection Area, call 250 248-3242; to report a fire emergency call 911.

Complaints can be submitted in person, by mail, by email or by phone. Your contact information will be kept confidential.

<u>Beach fires are not permitted at any time in the Parksville Qualicum</u> <u>Wildlife Management Area</u> which includes the entire waterfront area in the Parksville Fire Protection Area. Because Parksville beaches are provincial jurisdiction, beach fires should be reported to the RAPP line (Report All Poachers and Polluters) at:
