Fireworks Bylaw No. 1427

Can I set off fireworks in Parksville?

- No. You may not possess or set off any type of fireworks or firecrackers anywhere within the City without a permit.

How do I get a permit?

- Permit applications must be made in writing to the City operations department at least 30 days prior to the fireworks event.
- Permits are only issued to applicants with a Fireworks Supervisor and/or Pyrotechnics Certification card as issued by Natural Resources Canada.
- Other requirements including acceptable insurance must be satisfied before a permit will be issued.

Can I sell fireworks in Parksville?


- No. The sale of any type of fireworks is prohibited.

MAKING A COMPLAINT

To make a bylaw complaint you need to provide:

- Nature of the complaint (sale or discharge of fireworks)
- Time, date and other details of incident.
- Location/address of incident.
- Your name, address, phone number, and email.



Complaints can be submitted in person, by mail, by email or by phone.
Your contact information will be kept confidential.
