Since the last project update in July, the design team has been focused on creating streetscape concepts for review by City Council and to present to the community. The concepts that we have created address the numerous challenges and opportunities inherent to historic Memorial Avenue, including the beautiful memorial trees. Input from the community is strongly reflected in these concepts and the project team is very excited to share our work!

Parksville Council will review the concepts and accompanying report on December 2. City staff will provide a presentation to Council to share what we heard from the public consultation and which concept is recommended by staff based on the community's visions for Memorial Avenue and multiple technical requirements. Once Council has chosen a preferred concept, we will present this concept to the community for your feedback.

Our project team arborist also performed a second review of the memorial trees to assess their late summer condition, gaining additional understanding of their individual needs. The trees received additional deep-root watering through the summer to improve their health and help preserve these living monuments to civic service. Additional information about the memorial trees has been added to the project website.

Thank you for your continued support and interest in this project. We will continue to update you as we proceed through each phase of this project and we look forward to sharing our vision for Memorial Avenue soon.
