Alberni Highway Paving

Haylock Paving has been contracted to provide overlay paving which can help extend the life of the pavement structure to better align with underlying utilities, improve the overall condition, safety and road experience while optimizing costs to the City.

Alberni Highway between Despard Avenue West and Jensen Avenue West will be closed for paving from April 22 to April 25. Detour routes will be available on Moilliet Street or Despard Avenue West to Craig Street from 7 am to 6 pm daily. From April 28 to May 2, there will be single lane alternating for vehicles during shouldering and line painting work.

Outside of regular construction hours, property access will be maintained. Residents affected by the work will be notified when paving is scheduled in their area. Please ensure vehicles are not parked or obstructing the road during paving. During construction, vehicular traffic may experience minor delays and congestion. To ensure safety and smooth traffic flow, traffic control personnel will be present on-site; follow instructions and observe construction signs. Next Steps in Parksville's 2025-2029 Financial Plan
At the April 9 Committee of the Whole meeting, Council provided direction

regarding the 2025-2029 financial plan with the recommendations to be brought forward to the April 23 Council meeting. The amended financial plan bylaw and the 2025 water, sewer and property tax rates bylaws will receive three readings at the May 5 meeting and a special Council meeting on May 7 will be held to provide final adoption of the bylaws.

Parksville Utility Bills Due April 30

Utility notices mailed twice a year to bill for water, sewer and solid waste (garbage, green bin and recycling services) will have arrived in mailboxes. If you have not yet received your bill in the mail, contact the City's finance department at 250 248-6144 or cashier@parksville.ca

Water Conservation Levels

- Level 1, in effect for April, allows for odd numbered civic addresses may water on odd numbered days and even numbered civic addresses may water on even numbered days.
- Level 2 will be in effect from May to October unless
 otherwise notified. Odd numbered civic addresses may water on odd
 numbered days and even numbered addresses may water on even numbered
 days. Watering times are 7 am to 10 am OR 7 pm to 10 pm for a maximum of
 two hours of total allocated watering per day.
- Vegetable gardens and fruit trees are exempt from restrictions.

Temporary closure of Parksville beaches to dogs

Rathtrevor Beach and Parksville Bay beach is closed to dogs until April 30. This closure is in effect for both on-leash and off-leash within Parksville-Qualicum Beach Wildlife Management Area.

Recycle BC pop-up depot in Parksville will continue through 2025, accepting free of charge, flexible plastic packaging, white and coloured foam packaging, glass packaging and paper packaging and cardboard. Materials may be dropped off from
