

Englishman River Water Treatment Plant Operations OCTOBER UPDATES

- Crews shifted to winter operating conditions providing continuous monitoring, testing, and membrane cleans in response to heavy rains and seasonal turbidity levels in the river.
- The draft budget has been prepared for the ERWS and AWS Board Meetings on November 17, 2021.

 and outdoor activities such as camping and hunting.


UPCOMING

- Final performance tests are scheduled end of November for the overall process system at the plant. The contractor will be onsite mid-November to prepare the system for testing.
- The Geobag dewatering system construction is starting in November and we anticipate testing, commissioning and completion in early January 2022, weather permitting.
- Arrowsmith Dam Safety Review Request for Proposal to be issued, complying with provincial legislation.


Watershed and Dam Level Update

- Just downstream of the Intake Structure, a large tree fell into the river and washed away within a week. No obstructions or negative impacts to our system were observed.
- Arrowsmith Lake Dam is at **65.6% full**, above average for this time of year. One benefit of the recent heavy rains is the dam is filling up faster than normal. October consumption was back to regular fall/winter conditions.


Monthly Production and Consumption Facts
