"ZONING AND DEVELOPMENT AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2023, NO. 2000.147"
proposes to amend "City of Parksville Zoning and Development Bylaw, 1994, No. 2000."

In general terms, the purpose of the proposed amendment bylaw is to facilitate a residential care use or facility for up to four persons receiving special care or assistance where single family dwelling is permitted.
