

In-person Attendance at Council Meetings

With the BC Restart plan and new guidelines for public meetings, expanded in-person attendance at Parksville Council meetings is available to the public. Residents continue to have the choice to attend virtually.

Aligned with Public Health Order restrictions, the maximum number of residents who can be accommodated in the Parksville Civic and Technology Centre for a Council meeting is **forty (40)** with ten spaces allocated to Council and support staff. To keep everyone safe, we ask that the public consider these points when attending a Council meeting:

- Please do not attend in-person unless fully vaccinated.
- Masks are mandatory at all times while in the building.
- You must remain seated when in attendance at the Council meeting.
- Stay home if sick or not feeling well.

Council meetings are webstreamed live and archived from the City's [website](#) with highlights of Council meetings posted to the website following the meeting.

Council agendas are posted to the website and comments related to the agenda may be submitted by phone (250 954-3060) or by email to council@parksville.ca, by 9 am on meeting day. Council meetings are held the first and third Monday of the month, starting at 1 pm.
