

Beach Access Ramp in Parksville Community Park

The City of Parksville is taking steps to remove the concrete beach access ramp in the Parksville Community Park which has collapsed and is now a safety and environmental concern.

The ramp will be decommissioned and the space rehabilitated with support from a qualified environmental professional to plan and undertake most of the work. The City is required to obtain provincial permits for removal of the ramp located on the foreshore; however, we hope to be able to remove the upper portion of the ramp soon. In the meantime, the area near the ramp has been cordoned off for the safety of the public.

The cost of this rehabilitation work is eligible for provincial Local Government Climate Action Partnership funding.
