

## 2026 Canada Day Celebrations in Parksville

Here's an update to Parksville's Canada Day when we celebrate the 159<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Canada's confederation. Hosted by the City of Parksville, we strive to make the day the best free, family-friendly event for the community. The day kicks off with the Canada Day parade and pancake breakfast followed by activities and events in the Parksville Community Park.

### CANADA DAY PARADE

10 am	Island Highway East (Shelly Road to Alberni Highway)
7.30-11 am	Shriners' breakfast - Craig Street (Middleton to Island Highway)
8.30-10.30 am	Music with Chaz Booth - Craig Street

**Please note** – to address safety concerns at large events, we will institute new safety measures in 2026. As announced in March, the parade will end at Craig Street on the Island Highway. The parade will not travel up Craig Street. Enhanced safety measures include additional traffic control and security, more street barricades, more signage, additional hours for first-aid service, pedestrian only access on Pioneer Crescent at the start of the parade with parade dispersal on Harrison Avenue.
