

Rolling Parade Scheduled for Legion's 100th Anniversary Event

The Royal Canadian Legion Branch #49, in conjunction with the City of Parksville, will be completing a rolling parade on Saturday, September 19 to honour and commemorate the 100th anniversary of Branch #49 and the distinguished service to communities across Canada. The parade will begin at roughly 10 am and finish before 11 am, with traffic control personnel providing temporary closures along the route. Thank you in advance for your patience.

The parade will start behind the Civic and Technology Centre (100 Jensen Avenue W), run north along Craig Street, and turn left on Hirst Avenue East, finishing in the Legion parking lot at 146 Hirst Avenue West (map below).

Residents and visitors are welcome to watch the parade as it makes its way to the Legion. Once the parade has completed, the public is welcome to join participants and other dignitaries to honour and celebrate the veterans in our community.
