

Council Priorities Survey Extended

Through a survey on the City's website, Parksville Council is seeking input from Parksville residents to help determine Council's strategic priorities for the next three years. We have had great response from residents and will keep the survey open until June 18.

This extension will provide residents with the opportunity to comment further on the subjects being discussed at Committee of the Whole meetings on May 22 (recreation and healthcare) and June 3 (affordable housing) and June 17 (downtown revitalization and economic development).
