

Chesapeake Shores to Film at Parksville Civic and Technology Centre

Chesapeake Shores will use the Parksville Civic and Technology Centre (PCTC) on April 27 through April 29 for filming purposes, working within strict COVID-19 restrictions. Filming will take place on April 28, both inside and outside the PCTC building, with set up on April 27 and the morning of April 29 for teardown and cleaning.

Please note, PCTC will be open to the public as usual to access the City's finance department to make payments. Finance is open from 9 am to noon and 1 pm to 3 pm with access from Jensen Avenue East. Masks are mandatory and visitors will be asked for contact information for contact tracing purposes.

Parking disruptions:

- Beginning the evening of April 27 through end of the day on April 28, a portion of the gravel lot at Jensen and Craig will be reserved for Chesapeake Shores vehicles; public parking will also be available in this lot.
- On April 28, in addition to limited parking in the Craig/Jensen gravel lot, a portion of the library parking lot will be used for filming. Parking spaces will be available for public access to the library during this time.
- April 27 through April 29, some of the street parking spaces on Craig Street alongside the PCTC building will be unavailable.

We are aware this will be an inconvenience for some; however, we are pleased to be able to accommodate Chesapeake Shores return to Parksville. We appreciate the public's patience as we accommodate their requests.
