Parkville Fire Prevention Open House - October 3

Each year, the Parkville Fire Department recognizes Fire Prevention Week (October 3 to 9) and this year will host an open house on **Sunday, October 3 from 10 am to 3 pm**. The event will take place at the training centre, 1159 Franklin's Gull Road in the Industrial Park.

The public is encouraged to drop by for some fun and to learn about fire prevention. As events are outside, we encourage residents to dress for the weather and be sure to bring your camera. Demonstrations scheduled as follows:

11 am	Auto extrication
1 pm	High angle rope
2 pm	Motor vehicle fire
3 pm	Side-by-side burn

The final event of the day is a side-by-side burn demonstration at 3 pm which will feature two similarly furnished rooms; one protected with fire sprinklers and the other without fire sprinklers. People who attend the demonstration will be able to view firsthand how quickly a fire can become deadly versus the quick response and effectiveness of a fire sprinkler system in controlling or extinguishing a fire.

Other activities for the day include educational displays, hose and target practice, home sprinkler display, rides in a fire truck and fire prevention materials to share. Members will answer questions about recruitment and fire safety and our most popular mascots will look to share an elbow or fist bump with everyone.

The theme for this year's fire prevention week is ***Learn the Sounds of Safety*** which puts the focus on educating everyone about smoke and carbon monoxide alarms, their necessity and how the sounds they make help save lives. Understanding the different sounds alarms make and knowing what to do when an alarm sounds will keep you and your family safe. Parkville Fire would like families to focus on fire prevention by planning and integrating a few simple fire safety behaviours into everyday lives. By paying attention and eliminating potential fire hazards in your home, you can make a difference that will prevent or reduce fire related injuries, deaths and property damage.
