Highlights from Council Meeting on November 15, 2021

Mayor Mayne recognized the Coast Salish peoples and their traditional territory upon which we gather with gratitude.

Presentations

- K. Love and S. Foster from BGC Central Vancouver Island provided an update to Council on the ability to offer space to the community at the Parksville Community Centre and how the BGCCVI will collaborate with community agencies to ensure the needs of families and communities are served.
- L. Gardner from the Regional District of Nanaimo gave an overview on the Mandatory Source Separation Bylaw and Waste Hauler Licensing Bylaw, explained their purpose and the timeline for approval/adoption as well as status update on the project.

Correspondence

- Council consented on behalf of the electors, to adoption of "Regional Parks and Trails Service Area Amendment Bylaw No. 1231.08, 2021".
- Council consented on behalf of the electors, to adoption of "Northern Community Sewer Local Service Amendment Bylaw No. 889.77, 2021".

Reports

- Council received a rise and release report from the November 1, 2021, closed Council meeting regarding the BGCCVI use of the Parksville Community Centre.
- Council approved the Council appointments for the period November 2, 2021, to November 6, 2022.
- Council authorized entering into an agreement with Shaw Business for the provision of internet services for a term of five years.
- Council issued a Development Permit to the owners of 1116 Herring Gull Way to facilitate the installation of a dewatering filtration system.
- Staff were directed to provide notice of Council's intent to consider issuance of Development Variance Permit to the owners of 331 and 343 Moilliet Street South to facilitate the proposed height of a combined fence and retaining wall.
- Staff were directed to provide notice of Council's intent to consider issuance of Development Variance Permit to the owner of 113 Hirst Avenue East to facilitate a mixed commercial/multi-family residential building.
- Council approved the Non-Medical Cannabis Retail Store application by Kaya Connection Ltd. for the store named Kaya Connection at unit 101 at 124 Craig Street.

Notice of Motion

- The motion to amend the Procedure Bylaw to add a requirement that Council members only be permitted to speak a maximum of two times on a particular subject, unless the member is raising new information that has not already been considered by Council, was defeated.
